System Saver 1200 Plus Air Dryer Kit

The kit includes the following parts.

1	Adapter bracket (for use when replacing the Bendix AD9 air dryer)
3	1/2" bolts
3	1/2" lock washers
4	3/8" bolts
4	3/8" flat washers
4	3/8" lock washers

Replacing a Bendix AD9 Air Dryer with a System Saver 1200 Plus Air Dryer

Replacement Procedure

WARNING

To prevent serious eye injury, always wear safe eye protection when you perform vehicle maintenance or service.

Park the vehicle on a level surface. Block the wheels to prevent the vehicle from moving. Support the vehicle with safety stands. Do not work under a vehicle supported only by jacks. Jacks can slip and fall over. Serious personal injury and damage to components can result.

Release all air from the air systems before you remove any components. Pressurized air can cause serious personal injury.

1. Wear safe eye protection.
2. Park the vehicle on a level surface. Block the wheels to prevent the vehicle from moving.
3. Open the drain valves on the system reservoirs and allow the reservoirs to empty completely.
4. Disconnect the inlet hose, outlet hose, signal line and heater electrical connector from the air dryer.
5. Remove the mounting bolts and remove the Bendix AD9 air dryer.

NOTE: The System Saver 1200 Plus air dryer has two mounting surfaces to provide the best orientation of the air dryer for hose connections.

6. Determine which mounting surface on the System Saver Plus air dryer provides the best orientation for the installation of the hoses. Place the supplied bracket onto the selected surface. Install the lock washers and the 1/2" bolts. Tighten the bolts to 52 ± 2 ft-lb (70 ± 3 N•m). 

7. Position the System Saver 1200 Plus air dryer with the bracket onto the existing vehicle bracket on which the Bendix AD9 air dryer was mounted. Secure the air dryer to the bracket using the supplied 3/8" hardware. Tighten the fasteners to 30 ± 2 ft-lb (40 ± 3 N•m). 
8. Install the hose fittings to the System Saver 1200 Plus air dryer. You may choose to reuse the hose fittings from the Bendix AD9 air dryer or install new hose fittings. Orientate the fittings to provide easy connection to the air lines.
9. Connect the compressor discharge line to port 1 on the System Saver 1200 Plus air dryer.
10. Connect the air dryer outlet line from the system reservoirs to port 21 on the bottom of the System Saver 1200 Plus air dryer.
11. Connect the signal line from the governor to port 4 of the System Saver 1200 Plus air dryer.
12. Connect the heater electrical connector to the System Saver 1200 Plus air dryer.
13. Start the vehicle. Allow the system to build pressure and check for leaks. If any leaks are found, repair as necessary.
14. Test the vehicle brakes before you return the vehicle to service.
